Page 22, line 15.5, INSERT New Finding of Fact:

"Future Programs

In its application, the Company has proposed a customer repayment financing program element for schools, municipalities, and small businesses which will be integrated with the appropriate Non-Residential programs. Notably, the Company did not propose similar measures for its residential programs and residential customers. While the Company's non-residential proposal is not addressed in the instant application it should be addressed in a forthcoming proceeding.

The Commission specifically, is concerned that the Company's exclusion of a residential repayment financing program would detrimentally limit the reach of energy efficiency programs at a time when all efficiencies must be pursued, and all ratepayers should be afforded a fair and realistic opportunity to access cost saving energy efficiency measures. Given the indisputable importance of energy efficiency as a tool for meeting Arizona's electric needs, the Commission believes it is imperative that all cost-effective energy efficiency be achieved and further believes customer repayment financing for residential customers would help broaden the availability of residential programs.

Accordingly, the Commission will require, as a condition of this order, that the Company file a residential repayment financing program, as a supplement to the 2010 implementation application, which will address timeframes for implementation of such a program and tariffs. Specifically, we would like to see an option for on the utility bill repayment or an option which would allow customers the option to repay energy efficiency measures through a parallel bill in a manner similar to the utility bill. Examples of such programs can be found in the Pennsylvania Keystone HELP Program, the Manitoba Hydro Residential On Bill Repayment Loans Program, and the Kansas Midwest Energy On The Bill Tariff approach. The Company shall file the supplement with Docket Control by February 26, 2010 for Commission consideration."

Page 23, line 6.5, INSERT NEW ORDERING PARAGRAPH:

"IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Company file a residential repayment financing program, as a supplement to the 2010 implementation application, which will address timeframes for implementation of such a program and tariffs. The supplement shall include an option for on the utility bill repayment and an option which would allow customers the option to repay energy efficiency measures through a parallel bill in a manner similar to the utility bill. The Company shall file the supplement with Docket Control by February 26, 2010 for Commission consideration."
