Page 18, Line 8.5, INSERT NEW FINDING OF FACT:

“Third Party Assignment of Incentives”

The Commission encourages SSVEC to adopt best practices with regard to RES program incentive disbursement. Currently, Arizona Public Service and Tucson Electric Power offer customers, eligible for distributed generation (DG) rebates, the option to assign those rebates to a third party. Typically, this is the installer of the renewable energy system. Third party assignment helps ensure that the transactions associated with renewable energy installations are not delayed because of cash flow issues. It improves the percentage of DG projects initiated through the reservation project that are actually completed. As a result, it gives utilities greater assurance that incentive monies, that have been reserved, will actually result in the production of RECs in a timely manner.

Page 19, line 6.5, INSERT NEW ORDERING PARAGRAPH:

“IT IS FURTHER OREDERD that SSVEC should allow customers the option to assign the incentive payments associated with distributed generation renewable energy systems to the installer, if they choose so. “
