Page 13, **DELETE** Item 53.

Page 18, **DELETE** Item 75 and **REPLACE** with New Finding of Fact:

“The Commission finds that because SSVEC obligated most of the 2010 REST collections to a single, high-cost project, and because the Commission believes greater oversight over SSVEC’s budget allocations is warranted, that SSVEC not be allowed to shift budget allocations mid-year and later. The Commission finds that the Large-Scale Renewables allocation of \$800,000 in Table VIII on page 12, line 24 of this Order be reduced to zero, and that the funds instead be put into the SunWatts Residential Rebates program so that the total for the SunWatts Residential Rebates Program on page 12, Table VIII, line 25 is increased from \$444,381 to \$1,244,381. If the SunWatts Residential Rebates program is allocated only \$444,381 as requested by SSVEC, only one-third of the current backlog of residential solar will be funded.”
