

Dear Mr. Carroll:

Thank you for your response to my letter of December 17, 2009 and my First Set of Data Requests dated December 1, 2009. I appreciate your efforts to respond to my request. However, the proposal outlined in your letter of December 21, 2009 is neither reasonable nor practical. If I had been an intervenor during the first hearings, I would have automatically received these documents as hard copies by mail. These are the basic documents in this re-hearing case. And it is necessary that my files match both your files as well as those of the Commission. As you are aware, color printing in some documents is lost in the e-docket files and many of the scanned documents are not readable.

The below outlines my preferences for your response:

For DR 1-1 (Copy of All Data Requests and Responses for the original and this re-hearing, including any and all future data requests and responses) in order of preference:

1. A hard copy of all pages, to match documents on file with the Commission,
2. A hard copy of all pages that are in color with CD-ROM for the rest of documents, or
3. A CD-ROM with color copies of each page.

For DR1-2 (A copy of the Original Application, all Briefs, and the Re-hearing Application on these matters) in order of preference:

1. A hard copy of all pages including requests and responses or
2. A CD-ROM of all pages including requests and responses.
