PROCEDURAL ORDER
(Schedules a Status Conference)

BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 16, 2009, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against MJG Enterprises, Inc. ("MJG"), Anthony Boscarino (a/k/a Mike Brown and Anthony Kakas) and Marguerite Jeane Gearhart (a/k/a Marguerite Boscarino) (collectively "Respondents") in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of investment contracts.

The Respondents were duly served with copies of the Notice.

On November 18, 2009, a request for hearing was filed by Respondents.

On December 3, 2009, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled on January 7, 2010.

On January 7, 2010, the Division and Respondents appeared through counsel. The parties are discussing a possible settlement of the proceeding and agreed that a status conference be scheduled in approximately 45 days.

Accordingly, a status conference should be scheduled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **status conference** shall be held on **February 25,**

1 **2010, at 9:30 a.m.**, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Room 100, Phoenix,
2 Arizona.


3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized
4 Communications) applies to this proceeding as the matter is now set for public hearing.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal or representation must be made in compliance
6 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the
7 Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearances
8 at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is
9 scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the
10 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules
12 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to practice of law and admission
13 *pro hac vice*.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
15 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.
