I am not in favor of Trico's request for a reset date of March or April for solar systems. I would request that they be required to have a reset date of October, the same as Tucson Electric Power. This will allow the people who pay the expense of a system to use power saved in the winter months for a summer offset. If Trico is allowed to have a March or April reset, then they are cancelling out all consumer benefit, while claiming credit for our solar systems.

Trico currently is receiving quite a benefit from people who already installed solar, and they pay much less back for power on your reset date. Our solar will be installed later this year.
