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Chuck Essigs will provide testimony on behalf of the Arizona School Boards Association (“ASBA”) and the Arizona Association of School Business Officials (“AASBO”). ASBA is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit, membership-driven association of more than 240 Arizona public school governing boards. Its members represent 1,200 plus school board members and over 1.12 million Arizona children. ASBA’s mission is to promote community volunteer governance of public education and continued improvement of student success by providing leadership and assistance to public school governing boards.

ASBO provides services to members in school districts in Arizona. It has approximately 1,300 members. It provides a number of conferences and training classes to school district employees and provides information to members on the laws and regulations that impact the business operation of school districts.

Mr. Essigs’ testimony proposes that UNS Electric develop renewable energy and energy efficiency programs for Arizona’s public schools similar to those approved by the Commission in Docket No. E-01345(A)-08-0172 for Arizona Public Service Company. Additionally, he proposes that UNS Electric design a new optional time TOU rate applicable to K-12 schools designed to provide daily and seasonal price signals to encourage load reductions during peak periods.
