PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On January 14, 2010, Sulphur Springs Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("SSVEC" or "Cooperative") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") a Petition to Amend Decision No. 71274 Pursuant to A.R.S. §40-252 and for Related Authorization ("Petition") in Docket No. E-01575A-08-0328. At a Special Open Meeting of the Commission held on February 3, 2010, the Commission passed a Motion to "grant Sulphur Springs Valley Electric Cooperative's Petition to Amend Decision No. 71274 Pursuant to A.R.S. §40-252 and for Related Authorization for the purposes of further consideration of whether Decision No. 71274 should be amended and the request for related authorization should be approved; and, also grant the Cooperative's request for expedited consideration of its Petition and direct the Hearing Division to conduct appropriate proceedings and prepare a recommended opinion and order for Commission consideration on an expedited basis.


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1 On February 4, 2010, Sulphur Springs filed a Request for Expedited Procedural Order.
2 SSVEC suggests that the expedited proceeding may take the form of an oral argument and that an
3 evidentiary hearing is not necessary or required. The Commission has directed expedited
4 consideration. Consequently, it is important to establish procedures as soon as possible.

5 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a **telephonic procedural conference** for the purpose of
6 establishing the procedures for considering SSVEC's January 15, 2010 Petition as directed by the
7 Commission in its February 3, 2010 Open Meeting, shall commence on **February 10, 2010 at 10:00**
8 **a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's Tucson offices, **Room 222, 400 West**
9 **Congress, Tucson**, Arizona 85701. Parties appearing telephonically should contact the Hearing
10 Division (602) 542-4250 for instructions for telephonic participation.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
12 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.

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
