I am opposed to this solar project being built using the Hualapai aquifer. A large amount of ground water will be used yearly. An aquifer is a source for water which gets only marginally replaced by Mother Nature. Therefore, any common usage depletes it. There is no accurate measurement of the volume of water within any aquifer due to the shape of the hole in the ground containing the water and very probably layers of rock or other substance throughout the water. One can attempt to say there is a particular amount of water for a one year term usage, but this facility plans to heat water to create steam to turn turbines to create electricity for approximately 20-30 years. Or until the water runs out. Personally I thought new Renewable Energies would use more modern processes.

I also am opposed to the financial aspects of this deal. Two-thirds of the millions of dollars will be stimulus money and one-third a government loan at 3% interest. The materials needed to build this project will be purchased from companies in foreign lands. So much for the tax-payers money, being fully used to stimulate the United States economy.
