PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 4, 2009, Coronado Utilities, Inc. ("Coronado" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a rate increase for wastewater service in the above-captioned docket.

On July 16, 2009, the Commission's Utility Division ("Staff") filed a Letter of Sufficiency in the docket indicating that Coronado's application had meet the sufficiency requirements of A.A.C. R14-2-103. Staff classified the Company as a Class B utility. By Procedural Order dated July 29, 2009, the matter was set for hearing on March 23, 2010, and deadlines for filing testimony established.

On January 6, 2010, Staff filed a Motion for a Revised Procedural Schedule. Staff reports that there was some confusion during the discovery period which delayed Staff's receipt of certain information and prevented Staff from filing its Direct Testimony by the January 11, 2010 deadline. Staff and the Company were able to reach agreement regarding a modification of the hearing schedule and request that a new hearing date and testimony deadlines be adopted. The Company has agreed to extend the time clock deadline through the end of August 2010.

The parties have cooperated to propose a schedule that is acceptable and fair to all parties, and it should be adopted. While the hearing date will be continued until May 5, 2010, the Commission

1 will hold a Public Comment Meeting on the application on the original date of March 23, 2010, as
2 this date has already been noticed to ratepayers.

3 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **hearing in this matter shall be continued until**
4 **May 5, 2010, at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices, 400
5 West Congress, Room 222, Tucson, Arizona 85701.¹

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a **telephonic pre-hearing conference shall be held on**
7 **May 3, 2010, at 10:00 a.m.**, at the Commission's Tucson Offices, Room 218, 400 West Congress,
8 Tucson, Arizona, for the purpose of scheduling witnesses and the conduct of the hearing. **Parties**
9 **wishing to participate shall contact the Hearing Division at (602) 542-4250 prior to the Pre-**
10 **hearing Conference date to obtain instructions for telephonic participation.**

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a **Public Comment Meeting** will commence on **March 23,**
12 **2010, at 10 :00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical at the Commission's Tucson Offices, Room
13 222, 400 West Congress, Tucson, Arizona.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **direct testimony** and associated exhibits to be presented at
15 **hearing on behalf of Staff and intervenors shall be reduced to writing and filed on or before**
16 **February 12, 2010.**

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any **rebuttal testimony** and associated exhibits to be
18 **presented at hearing by the Company shall be reduced to writing and filed on or before March 22,**
19 **2010.**

20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any **surrebuttal testimony** and associated exhibits to be
21 **presented by Staff or intervenors shall be reduced to writing and filed on or before April 16, 2010.**

22 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any **rejoinder testimony and associated exhibits** to be
23 **presented at hearing by the Company shall be reduced to writing and filed on or before May 3, 2010.**


24 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
25 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the
26 *Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.*

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28 ¹ If a third day of hearing is required, the hearing will reconvene in Room 100 at the Commission's Phoenix offices.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other provisions specified in the July 29, 2010,
2 Procedural Order shall remain in effect.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
4 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
5 hearing.


