It appears that for some time, the customers of Bella Vista Water Co. have been paying considerably less for their water than the customers of Northern and Southern Sunrise Water Companies. I am not sure how this has been allowed to happen, but it is not an equitable situation. The consolidation and transfer of assets from NSWC and SSWC to BVWC would rectify this inequity. Customers of all three companies would pay approximately the same rates. If the consolidation were not approved and NSWC and SSWC were granted rate increases, the inequity would be even much greater.

In fact, the NSWC customers would not be able to afford to use water even on a minimal basis. A 144 percent raise in water bills, as proposed in the rate increase for NSWC, would, in fact, bankrupt many of the families that are already struggling to make ends meeting these difficult financial times.

I strongly encourage the Arizona Corporation Commission to grant the application to transfer assets and consolidate operations.
