PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 2, 2009, Arizona-American Water Company ("Arizona-American" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for rate increases for its Anthem Water District, Sun City Water District, Anthem/Agua Fria Wastewater District, Sun City Wastewater District, and Sun City West Wastewater District.

A hearing date and associated procedural deadlines were set in a Rate Case Procedural Order issued on September 24, 2009.

Intervention in this matter has been granted to the Residential Utility Consumer Office ("RUCO"), Anthem Community Council, Sun City West Property Owners and Residents Association, W.R. Hansen, and the Water Utility Association of Arizona.

1 On February 2, 2010, a procedural order was issued granting a request by the Commission's
2 Utilities Division ("Staff") to extend the time deadline for Staff to file its rate design testimony. The
3 procedural order extended the time deadline for Staff and intervenors to file their rate design
4 testimony from March 8, 2010, to March 22, 2010. The time deadline for the Company to file
5 rebuttal testimony on the issue of rate design was also extended, from March 22, 2010, to April 5,
6 2010.

7 On February 18, 2010, RUCO filed a Motion to Extend the Time to File its Direct Required
8 Revenue Testimony ("Motion"). The Motion requests a one week extension of time for RUCO to file
9 its direct testimony on issues other than rate design. RUCO stated in the Motion that it needs more
10 time due to the amount of discovery on issues that have required analysis.

11 RUCO's Motion indicated that counsel for the Company informed RUCO that it does not
12 object to RUCO's proposed extension of time.

13 RUCO's request is reasonable and should be granted.

14 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that any testimony and associated exhibits to be presented at
15 hearing on behalf of Staff and intervenors **on issues other than rate design** shall be reduced to writing
16 and filed on or before **March 1, 2010**.

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other filing deadlines set forth in the September 24,
18 2009 Rate Case Procedural Order, as modified by the procedural order issued February 2, 2010, shall
19 remain unchanged.

20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized
21 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the
22 Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

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1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
2 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
3 hearing.
