We are a residents in the operating territory of the Little Park Water Company, Inc. [which represents approximately 70 customers in our community]. We have been made aware of the rate filing referenced above that will greatly increase our monthly water costs.

We do understand the need for increased funding is needed for capital infrastructure improvements and general operating cost increases. As identified in the notification from Little Park Water Company, Inc., the increase is approximately [112%] which we feel is excessive even in the best of economic times. Considering the economic times we are all facing we urge the commission t look for alternatives to increasing the costs this amount at this time. It would make sense to extend the recovery asked for over an extended period of time to minimize its immediate impact. We urge the commission to review this compants operating expenses to identify and suggest alternatives to this large cost increase.

All to often rate requests for a one hme investment result into ongoing charges that are not managed and relief to customers are gone. This should not be allowed as it drives up costs over the long term.

We will continue to watch the progiess of the rate request review and look forward to the creative suggestions, and methods, which can be applied to minimize both the immediate and eventual ongoing cost impacts to all of us here.
