

Dear Jack Blair, we support the implementation of the Sonoita Reliability Project. This is the text of an email we sent today to the ACC Chair and Commissioners:

\ "Chairwoman Mayes, Commissioners Kennedy, Newman, Pierce, and Stump: we urge you to expeditiously approve SSVEC\'s plan to construct a 69kV transmission power line from Mustang Corners to Sonoita.

1. Numerous public meetings have been conducted by the ACC and numerous studies have been financed by SSVEC, a non-profit, member-owned utility
2. The plan is supported by the ACC staff and by the results of an ACC-directed independent study
3. It is a waste of Coop money to continue to stonewall implementation of the plan by withholding your approval
4. Further delay could result in the lose of federal stimulus money currently available to fund the project

We also ask that Commissioner Newman recuse himself from further involvement in this matter as it appears to us that he is unable to objectively consider SSVEC\'s request because of his demonstrated contempt toward the Coop and its rate-paying members in rural Southeastern Arizona whom he describes as \ "redneck\".

We have been members of the Coop since 1976 and are very satisfied with the service the Coop has provided us during our 34 year membership.\ "

To Whom it May Concern:


As I understand it, SSVEC acquired a utility easement to run a 69 KV line to the Sonoita, Elgin area in the early 1980's. So why not do it already!
