I am sending this E-Mail to solicit your YES Vote to allow SSVEC to get on with building the much needed power service upgrade to the Sonoita area.

I think it is time to say that enough of this bureaucratic madness is enough. As a member of the SSVEC since 1979 I, have never had a complaint with how the CO-OP has been managed nor with the services that they have provided. This delay to the subject line has done little to nothing other than to verify what has been presented to the ACC in the first place at a considerable cost to the members of the SSVEC.

Any of the valid complainers, who would be affected in some way by the new line, had to have been advised by their realtors (under full disclosure by law when they bought their property) that there was a SSVEC Power Line planned for installation in the future.
