PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 24, 2009, TracFone Wireless, Inc. ("TracFone") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for designation as an Eligible Telecommunications Carrier ("ETC") for the limited purpose of offering Lifeline and Link Up service in Arizona.

On July 27, 2009, TracFone filed a First Amendment to Petition for Designation as an ETC.

On August 7, 2009, Applicant filed a Revised First Amendment to its application.

On October 28, 2009, TracFone filed a Second Amendment to its application.

On December 18, 2009, the Arizona Local Exchange Carriers Association ("ALECA") filed a Motion to Intervene ("Motion") in this proceeding. The Motion states ALECA is comprised of small telephone companies and member-owned cooperatives, all of which provide local exchange telecommunications services to customers in rural, high cost areas of Arizona. In its Motion, ALECA expressed concern that TracFone's offering may unfairly duplicate the similar offerings of its member companies.

On February 8, 2010, TracFone filed a response to ALECA's Motion, stating TracFone does not object to ALECA's intervention, and that its proposed services are not the same as those offered by ALECA member companies.

On February 19, 2010, by Procedural Order the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") was directed to file a response to ALECA's Motion.

1 On March 1, 2010, Staff filed a response to the ALECA's Motion, stating Staff has no
2 objection to the intervention.

3 Good cause has been shown for granting ALECA intervention in this proceeding.


4 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that ALECA is hereby granted intervention in this
5 proceeding.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules
7 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to practice of law in Arizona and
8 before the Commission and admission *pro hac vice*.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance
10 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the
11 Rules of Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearance at all
12 hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is scheduled
13 for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the
14 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend or waive
16 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.
