PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On January 28, 2002, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. 64375 directing that an investigation be commenced on an expedited basis to examine and address the Customer Proprietary Network Information ("CPNI") policies, notice and verification requirements of all telecommunications carriers providing service within the State of Arizona. Decision No. 64375 set a schedule for Staff to publish an issues list and for the parties to file comments. The Decision set May 15, 2002, as the date for a Workshop to discuss the filed comments and respond to questions.

Subsequent to the issuance of Decision No. 64375, the Commission, in the investigation of Qwest Corporation's compliance with Section 271 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (Docket No. T-00000A-97-0238), set two public comment meetings in Flagstaff and Prescott, Arizona on May 15, 2002.

On May 10, 2002, the Commission's Legal Division Staff contacted the Hearing Division and requested that the workshop be moved to Friday, May 17, 2002. Staff was directed to contact the parties to insure that they had no objections. No such objections have been received, and therefore, the workshop should be rescheduled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the remaining schedule for the CPNI investigation shall be modified as follows:

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
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
