Dear Sirs,

I am writing to ask that you authorize SSVEC to commence immediate construction of the 69 kV line serving the Elgin/ Patagonia/Sonoita area and the associated upgrades. For 40 years I have been a SSVEC custome living in SE Santa Cruz county, near the end of the longest distribution line in the SSVEC system and the one with the consistently highest outage rate. During the 1st 2 months this year I had over 5 hours of outages and that does not include the frequent brief interruptions or the low voltage brown outs that also occur. I am unable to attend the hearing do to a long standing prior committment but hope you will receive and consider my input.

I feel the ACC's Sept 8, 2009 decision was wrong, unfair to me and the other folks living near me and, should be reversed by allowing the construction with no further delays. SSVEC complete the required indepentent study which recommended implementing the original plan. Any further delays are effectively forcing SSVEC to continue providing it's customers with a substandard degraded quality of service. Is this the possition the ACC should be taking. NO!! Just the opposite.

While I am in favor of renewable energy programs they could be properly planned and implemented, not thrust piece meal into an existing project. I feel SSVEC has done a good job trying to placate a limited number of folks

who object to different aspect of this project. Now it's time to put a halt to further delay and get the necessary work accomplished. The small number of folks wanting to see wind or solar energy alternatives would be best to get them on their own if they feel strongly about them. SE AZ is known to be the poorest area in the state for both solar and wind electrical generation which would do little to help the basic problem in this case wich is still peak load capacity.
