Dear Chairman Mayes and Members of the Commission,

I received a letter from UNS Electric telling me about a meeting for the Citizens' Advisory Council in Green Valley on April 1st 2010 at 2:00pm.

There are some problems for this for me. I am in Vail which is several miles from Green Valley. The Vail to Valencia project does not even enter Green Valley. The new piece of the project that goes all of the way to Nogales does not have any other new projects connected with it.

The reason for the Citizens Advisory Council was to talk about regional and neighborhood transmission planning associated with this project. The letter is not clear. It says "Pursuant to the ACC's decision, UNS Electric is forming a voluntary Citizens Advisory Council ("CAC") **to provide input related to the project.** The Vail substation is the part that has new projects associated with it because of a new transformer for the Vail to Valencia project. This letter sounds like they want us to discuss something you already gave approval?

The meeting is being held just before Easter Weekend (day before Good Friday) and we already have plans. There is only one meeting, it is during the day and far away from the project. There is a number we can call if we want to be included later but why would they start out on the wrong foot? Corona de Tucson is much closer and very near the project. I am disappointed by the way this entire thing is being handled. It almost seems that they really do not want our input. They had many months to set up this meeting. I am sure that I could locate a place in Corona de Tucson to hold a second meeting. Why did they wait so long?
