**STAFF REQUEST FOR AN ADDITIONAL
TWO WEEKS TO FILE TESTIMONY**

On January 6, 2002, the Commission issued a Procedural Order requiring Staff to file testimony on February 7, 2003. Staff's testimony is to address, in part, the testimony filed by Qwest Corporation ("Qwest") on December 3, 2002, and the Residential Utility Consumer Office ("RUCO") on January 21, 2003. Due to the many complex issues raised, Staff requests that the date for Staff testimony/Intervenor Response to other Intervenor testimony be extended an additional two weeks to February 21, 2002. In addition, Staff respectfully requests that the remaining dates for Qwest rebuttal testimony, the Pre-hearing conference and the Hearing also be extended by two weeks.

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
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
