Please do not allow SSVEC to start their proposed 69kV line immediately. As explained on page 3 of the Feasibility Study *"The V - 7 customer peak is expected to increase to about 8000kW by 2029, above the Huachuca substation and V - 7 feeder ratings of approximately 7000kW; line and equipment losses will increase total loading to about 9000kW - the adjustment for losses will depend on which supply option is selected."*

**So Sonoita, Elgin and Patagonia only need 1,000kW (possibly 2,000kW) more in 20 years, not 60,000kW tomorrow!!** This is NOT an emergency and there are several options for reliable energy besides a \$14,000,000 - 69kV Power Line.

I've learned that SSVEC is bussing people from Sonoita to the hearing and providing lunch for them. This is an unfair way for our cooperative to operate.

Thank you for your attention to our community's problem with our utility cooperative.
