**MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE TO FILE REBUTTAL TESTIMONY**

Arizona-American Water Company ("AZ-American"), the Applicant in this docket, respectfully requests an additional two days, until April 7, 2010, to file its rebuttal testimony on the issue of rate design, including Staff's rate consolidation proposals.

1 Upon receipt and analysis of Staff's testimony on these issues, Arizona-American has  
2 recognized that a thorough response will require additional time. Arizona-American  
3 believes that a thorough response by Arizona-American will benefit other intervenors in  
4 formulating their testimony on the issue of rate design. In addition, Arizona-American  
5 submits that this request is reasonable in light of the extension of the deadlines for other  
6 parties to file testimony on these issues until May 3, 2010, and the fact that these issues will  
7 not be addressed during the first phase of the hearing commencing April 19, 2010.

8 Counsel for Arizona-American has consulted with counsel for Arizona  
9 Corporation Commission Staff, RUCO, Anthem Community Council, and the Resorts, and  
10 none of these parties has an objection to this extension.
