PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 4, 2009, Timber Knoll Homeowner's Association, Inc. dba T.K. Water Service ("TKW," "Company" or "Applicant") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for an increase in its permanent rates and charges.

On June 10, 2009, the Company filed certification that it had provided public notice of its rate application to its customers. In response thereto, the Commission received one comment concerning the proposed increase.

On July 6, 2009, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") issued a Notice of Insufficiency pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-103.

On December 16, 2009, Staff issued a Notice of Sufficiency indicating that the Company's rate application was sufficient, and classified the Company as a Class E utility.

On February 17, 2010, Staff filed its report recommending approval of its proposed rates and charges.

On March 1 and 5, 2010, the Company filed responses to the report filed by Staff.

On March 8, 2010, a recommended Order was issued in this matter.

On March 15, 17, 18 and 23, 2010, the Company filed exceptions to the Staff Report and the recommended Order.

On March 29, 2010, a TKW board member filed further exceptions on behalf of the Company.

1 On April 1, 2010, at the Commission's scheduled Open Meeting, the Company's secretary
2 participated in a discussion of the matter with the members of the Commission. Due to the issues, the
3 Chairman and members of the Commission deemed it appropriate to delay action on the Company's
4 application so that further discussions could be had between Staff and the representatives of the
5 Company.

6 Under the circumstances, pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-103, the timeframe should be suspended.
7 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that, pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-103, the timeframe in this
8 proceeding shall be suspended until further Order.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
10 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
11 hearing.


