On behalf of our client, the Amado Business Park, WestLand Resources, Inc. (WestLand) is providing this letter to describe the proposed wastewater treatment method for the Amado Business Park. Based on the plat information provided by the client, WestLand evaluated wastewater flow rates and treatment options and determined that the projected flow rates for the Amado Business Park would meet the requirements for a General Aquifer Protection Permit regulated under the Arizona Administrative Code (AAC) Title 18, Chapter 9 for a facility less than 3,000 gallons per day. WestLand also performed a site investigation of the said property to determine the absence of limiting surface and subsurface conditions (R18-9-A311.C). The Type 4 onsite wastewater treatment facility will be designed to meet the regulatory requirements for the proposed facility as described in, AAC R18-9-E302, and will generally consist of a septic tank and leach disposal field.
