I sent a correspondence to you on Saturday regarding our situation of being caught in the "in-between" land on the share rate change from 50% to 36%. I have just found out that we are "safe" in that our application was submitted in time. I am still very concerned though for all the others that will be affected by this change. APS created a plan for this year. That plan calculated how they would disperse the available funds, and with that arrived at a value of solar energy that would be created for that formula of distribution. That plan was presented to the Arizona public and widely published and broadcast by the media. Now, in mid stream, that plan is being changed, and even more critically, retroactive for many people caught in the process of submission. I consider this a breach-of-faith with the Arizona public. The plan should be carried out as previously approved. If a change is to be made, it should be for next year. APS has an obligation for this year to carry out the plan "you" approved for this year. No "take backs." Keep your good faith with the citizens of Arizona.
