("Commission") concerning residential distributed energy incentives.

Because of high customer demand, incentive funding for residential installations is being depleted at an unprecedented rate. In order to spread the remaining funds among more customers, APS has requested that the Commission approve a reduction in the residential incentives from \$3.00 per watt to \$2.15 per watt for photovoltaic systems (solar panels), and from \$0.75 to \$0.50 per first year kilowatt hour savings for solar water heaters.

APS has requested that the Commission rule on its request on an expedited basis, and that the incentive rate approved by the Commission be **retroactive to March 31, 2010**. The Commission has not yet ruled on APS' proposal.
