STAFF'S MOTION FOR ENTRY OF PROCEDURAL ORDER NUNC PRO TUNC CORRECTING DECISION NO. 71510

On March 17, 2010 the Commission issued Decision No. 71510 authorizing rates for Farmers Water Company ("Farmers" or "the Company"). It has come to the attention of Arizona Corporation Commission Staff ("Staff") that Decision 71510 does not list the authorized commodity rate for the 1-1/2 inch meter size.¹ Because a monthly usage rate is provided in the order,² it appears to Staff that the omission of an authorized commodity rate was inadvertent.

During the hearing and in pre-filed testimony Staff and the Company were in agreement regarding the inverted tier break-over points for 1-1/2 inch meters: 1-25,000 gallons for first tier commodity rates and over 25,000 gallons for second tier commodity rates.³ Furthermore, because the commodity rates ordered in Decision No. 71510 for first and second tier rates are \$1.90 and \$2.45 respectively across all other meter sizes above 5/8 inch meters; Staff believes the omission of identical tiered rates for 1-1/2 inch meters to have been inadvertent as well.

Therefore, Staff recommends a correction of Decision No. 71510 *Nunc Pro Tunc* pursuant to Rule of Civil Procedure, Rule 58 to reflect a commodity rate for Farmers' 1-1/2 inch meter customers. For the convenience of the Commission, Staff offers the proposed language to correct Decision No. 71510:

On Page 17, under the 1-Inch Meter (All Classes) commodity charge listing,
