RE: IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF CALIFORNIA PAYPHONE NETWORK FOR APPROVAL TO CANCEL A CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY FOR CUSTOMER OWNED PAY TELEPHONE (DOCKET NO. T-03786A-10-0114)

On March 30, 2010, California Payphone Network dba Consolidated Smart Systems ("CPN" or "Applicant") filed a request to cancel its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide customer owned pay telephone ("COPT") service. The Commission granted the Applicant a CC&N to provide COPT service in Decision No. 62773, dated August 2, 2000.

In the application, the Applicant indicates he is the authorized person to file the application and that CPN no longer provides, nor ever did provide, COPT service in the State of Arizona and requests cancellation of it CC&N. In addition, the Applicant waived his right to notice and a hearing in order to cancel the CC&N.

The Compliance Section of the Utilities Division indicates that the Applicant is in compliance. The Consumer Services Section has found the Applicant has not had any complaints, opinions or inquires about CPN. The Corporations Division reports no record was found for California Payphone Network. The Corporations Division further reports that Consolidated Smart Systems, Inc. merged with Consolidated Smart Systems Payroll Co. LLC on April 2, 2007.

As a COPT, CPN does not have any Arizona customers or end-user obligations such as those of competitive local exchange or long distance service providers. Consequently, there is no risk that advances, deposits, and/or prepayment funds would be lost by Arizona customers due to the cancellation of CPN's CC&N.

Staff recommends that the application to cancel the CC&N be approved. Upon cancellation of its CC&N, the Applicant will not be authorized to provide COPT telecommunications services in the state of Arizona and therefore, will not be subject to any of the requirements of Decision No. 62773.
