

On December 31, 2009, Las Quintas Serenas Water Company ("Company") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for an increase in annual revenues of \$203,528, an approximate 41.68 percent increase in annual revenue over its July 2008 through June 2009 revenues. Under the rates proposed by the Company, a residential customer with a 5/8 x 3/4-inch meter and average usage of 10,768 gallons per month would experience a monthly increase of \$11.35, or 34.44 percent, from \$32.95 to \$44.30. Customers using less or more than the average per month will experience a lower or higher percent increase depending on their usage. Under the Company's proposal, other rate class customer would experience varying percentage increases depending on their class and usage.
