PROCEDURAL ORDER

11 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

13 By Procedural Order dated November 23, 2009, a procedural schedule was established and a
14 hearing was set in the above-captioned matter.

15 On March 29, 2010, the Arizona Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. ("AEPCO" or
16 "Cooperative") filed a request for Procedural Conference to discuss revisions to AEPCO's rate filing
17 and a revised procedural schedule. AEPCO attached a revised schedule that had been agreed to
18 amongst all the parties to the docket.

19 On April 14, 2010, AEPCO, Trico, SSVEC MEC and Staff participated in a Procedural
20 Conference with the assigned Administrative Law Judge. AEPCO and its members reported they had
21 reached agreement on many of the issues in the rate case and would be filing revisions to the
22 application, and they confirmed that they were in agreement with the proposed revised procedural
23 schedule.

24 On April 20, 2010, AEPCO filed an Amended Application.

25 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the schedule originally set by Procedural Order dated
26 November 23, 2009, shall be modified as set forth herein.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDRED that the **hearing** in the above-captioned matter shall commence
 2 on **October 25, 2010, at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices,
 3 **Room 222, 400 West Congress, Tucson, Arizona 85701.**

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a **telephonic pre-hearing conference** shall be held on
 5 **October 18, 2010, at 10:00 a.m.** at the Commission's Tucson offices, Room 218, for the purpose of
 6 scheduling witnesses and the conduct of the hearing. **The parties should contact the Hearing**
 7 **Division at (602) 542-4250 to receive instructions for appearing telephonically.**

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the schedule for filing testimony is modified as follows:

18 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **any objections to any testimony or exhibits** which have
 19 been prefiled as of October 4, 2010, shall be made before or at the **October 18, 2010** pre-hearing
 20 conference.

21 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **intervention** shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R14-3-
 22 105, except that **all motions to intervene must be filed on or before June 15, 2010.**


23 IT IS FURTHER ORDRED that all other provisions of the November 23, 2009 Procedural
 24 Order not modified herein shall remain in effect.

25 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113-Unauthorized
 26 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding and shall remain in effect until the
 27 Commission's Decision in this matter is final and non-appealable.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time periods specified herein shall not be extended
2 pursuant to Rule 6(a) or (3) of the Rules of Civil Procedure.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
4 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


