6 Contemporaneously with this filing, the Applicant is providing a duplicate copy of  
7 this draft notice via email to the Hearing Division and all parties of record in electronic  
8 format to allow the Administrative Law Judge to make additions and revisions to the draft  
9 notice.

10 Finally, at the procedural conference, the Administrative Law Judge asked if any  
11 party had a preference as to whether the hearing should be held in Phoenix or  
12 Kingman. No party expressed a preference at that time. After further reflection, it is  
13 the Applicant's preference to hold the hearing in Kingman. Conference rooms are  
14 currently available the week of June 14 through 18, 2010, at the Kingman Powerhouse,  
15 located at 120 W. Andy Devine Avenue, Kingman, Arizona, 86402.



**Summary and Availability of Additional Information**

On April 14, 2010, the Arizona Corporation Commission (“Commission”) conditionally granted a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility (“CEC”) to Hualapai Valley Solar LLC (“Company”) and ordered that the matter be reopened to consider requests for intervention and conduct supplemental proceedings pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-252 to allow the Company and any intervenors to provide additional information on the issues in the initial CEC application. The Company’s application, the Commission’s April 14, 2010 Decision, and all other documents in the record are available for public inspection during regular business hours at the Commission’s Docket Control Center located at 1200 West Washington, Phoenix, Arizona, 85007, and on the internet via the Commission’s website ([www.azcc.gov](http://www.azcc.gov)) using the e-docket function.

**About Intervention**

Any person or entity entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter will be permitted to intervene. If you wish to intervene, you must file an original and 13 copies of a written motion to intervene with the Commission no later than **May 28, 2010**, and send a copy of the motion to intervene to the

Company or its counsel and to all parties of record. Your motion to intervene must contain the following:

1. Your name, address, and telephone number and the name, address and telephone number of any person upon whom service of documents is to be made if different from the intervenor.
2. A short statement of your interest in the proceeding.
3. A statement certifying that you have mailed a copy of the motion to intervene to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and providing public comment on the application or from filing written comments for the record of the case.
