

SECTION 2 – RULES AND REGULATIONS

2.16 Application of Rates and Charges (continued)

2.16.4 Application of Local Access Charges (continued)

- (C) If requested by the Customer, the Company will act as the Customer's agent for ordering and coordinating installation, re-arrangement or removal of Local Access facilities. Where Company acts as the Customer's agent for payment of Local Access charges, the Company will also pass along to the Customer Local Access Provider charges associated with the Customer's request order.
- (D) Subject to the availability of personnel, Company may perform other operational functions related to administration and maintenance of Local Access facilities. Such functions will be provided at non-standard installation, maintenance and engineering rates contained in this Tariff.

2.17 Taxes, Surcharges, and Fees

2.17.1 General

- (A) Customer will be responsible for the payment for all Services provided by the Company and for the payment of all excise, sales, use, gross receipts, or other taxes and surcharges. Federal excise tax, and state and local sales, use, and similar taxes and surcharges shall be billed separately from charges for Services. The Company may also impose surcharges on Customer to recover amounts it is required by governmental or quasi-governmental authorities to collect from, or to pay to, others in support of statutory or regulatory programs (e.g. universal service funds). The Company will not provide advance notice of changes to taxes and surcharges, except as required by law. Customers subscribing to both interstate and intrastate long distance service may be charged interstate fees in addition to the charges listed in this tariff.
