This letter is in protest strongly the proposed 63 percent rate increase by Sahuarita Water Company, LLC.

While a periodic rate increase by a utility is common and acceptable to cover increased costs, an increase of 63 percent is preposterous. This company has been providing water service in Sahuarita for about 11 years. This proposed increase would amount to an annual increase of some 5.7 percent, which is way out of line. Since its inception Sahuarita Water has increased its customer base by thousands of home (and businesses), increased facilities and equipment and has asked for no increase. Now, it seeks an increase of 63 percent, which makes no sense. Such an increase at this time indicates either poor management or greed on the part of the owners.

Understanding the current state of general economy, a rate increase of 5 to 7 percent would be acceptable and reasonable; NOT 63 PERCENT!
