PROCEDURAL ORDER
GRANTING ADMISSION
PRO HAC VICE

BY THE COMMISSION:

On June 7, 2010, pursuant to Arizona Supreme Court Rule 38(a), Douglas C. Northup, an attorney with Fennemore Craig, P.C., filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") a Motion to Temporarily Associate Counsel *Pro Hac Vice* for Michael S. Leib in the above-captioned matter, on behalf of the Respondent, Wells Fargo Investments, LLC.¹

On June 7, 2010, the Commission's Securities Division filed its Response to the Motion stating that it has no objection to the admission of Michael S. Leib as counsel *pro hac vice* in this matter.

On June 8, 2010, pursuant to Arizona Supreme Court Rule 38(a), Mr. Northup filed a Motion to Associate Counsel *Pro Hac Vice* Admission of Michael S. Leib. The Motion lists Mr. Northup as the designated member of the Arizona State Bar with whom communications may be made and upon whom papers should be served. Attached to the Motion is the Verified Application to Appear *Pro Hac Vice*; a copy of Mr. Leib's certificates of good standing from the jurisdictions in which he has been admitted to practice law; and a copy of the Notice of Receipt of Complete Application from the State Bar of Arizona.

In the discretion of the Commission, Michael S. Leib should be permitted to appear and participate in the above-captioned matter on behalf of Respondent, Wells Fargo Investments, LLC.

¹ The Motion indicated that temporary admission was sought pending completion of the State Bar of Arizona's application process.

Representation before the Commission includes the obligation to appear at all hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is scheduled for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the Administrative Law Judge.
