PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 1, 2010, Gary R. Bahr and Larry C. Rowley ("Complainants") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") a Complaint ("Complaint") against Time Warner Cable Information Services (Arizona), LLC, d/b/a Time Warner Cable ("Respondent").

On March 24, 2010, the Respondent filed its Motion to Dismiss the Complaint.

On May 7, 2010, a Procedural Order was filed setting a telephonic procedural conference in this matter for June 29, 2010, at 9:00 a.m.

Due to a scheduling conflict, the procedural conference must be rescheduled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the telephonic procedural conference in this matter currently scheduled for **June 29, 2010, at 9:00 a.m., is hereby vacated.**

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **oral argument on the Respondent's Motion to Dismiss**
2 **shall be heard during the July 1, 2010, procedural conference.**

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules
4 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. §40-243 with respect to practice of law and admission *pro*
5 *hac vice*.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that that the Presiding Administrative Law Judge may rescind,
7 alter, amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or
8 by ruling at hearing.
