13 required, and Staff, APS and TEP shall be provided an opportunity to clarify or expand on this pre-  
14 filed testimony during direct examination.

15 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties shall make every effort to provide same-  
16 day delivery of all pre-filed testimony/comments/disagreements.

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that APS and TEP shall make every effort to fax/hand  
18 deliver a copy of this Procedural Order to all the parties by the end of business, November 25, 1998.

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
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
