1. Whether the proposed settlement may affect the ability of Tucson

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1 Electric Power Company (TEP) to continue to perform the obligations of its
2 existing contracts, including those with M-S-R and SCPPA, and is therefore
3 not in the public interest.


4 2. Whether M-S-R and SCPPA's proposed conditions for approval of the
5 settlement, to be incorporated in the proposed order lodged by TEP, should be
6 adopted by the Commission as conditions for approval.

7 3. Whether any provisions of the Interim Code of Conduct, if
8 applicable at the time of divestiture of generation and other competitive
9 assets, could impair the ability of TEP to continue to perform the
10 obligations of its existing contracts.

11 4. Whether the approval of this settlement will precipitate accounting
12 practice changes or other TEP actions that would result in cost-shifting that
13 would impact M-S-R or SCPPA.

14 M-S-R and SCPPA also reserve the right to address subject areas covered
15 by other parties in either their pre-filed testimony or cross-examination.
