**tw telecom of arizona llc** (tw telecom), hereby requests permission to intervene in accordance with Rule 14-3-105 of the Arizona Corporation Commission Rules of Practice and Procedure, and in support of its request states as follows:

- tw telecom is certified to provide local exchange, intraexchange, and interexchange telecommunications services in Arizona.
- tw telecom is a party to an interconnection agreement with Qwest Corporation which is subject to section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("Act") and sets forth

the terms and conditions under which tw telecom and Qwest interconnect their telecommunications networks. tw telecom purchases unbundled network elements and other wholesale services from Qwest and competes with Qwest in the retail market. tw telecom has a direct and substantial interest in ensuring that Qwest, under new ownership, will provide unbundled network elements and wholesale services as required by the Act and pursuant to the tw telecom interconnection agreement.

3. tw telecom's participation in this proceeding will not unduly broaden the nature or scope of the Commission's inquiry.


