**STAFF'S RESPONSE TO
MOTION FOR EXTENSION
OF TIME**


On November 30, 1999, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") issued Decision No. 62103, which ordered Tucson Electric Power Company ("TEP") to file, for Commission approval, a proposed final Code of Conduct within 90 days of the date of that Decision.

On March 6, 2000 TEP filed a Motion for Extension of Time ("Motion") requesting a Procedural Order extending the filing date for TEP's proposed final Code of Conduct. TEP indicated in its Motion that TEP wishes to review the Commission-approved Arizona Public Service Company ("APS") Code of Conduct prior to filing its own proposed final Code of Conduct. TEP also refers in its Motion to use of the APS Code of Conduct "as a model for TEP's Final Code."

The Utilities Division Staff of the Commission ("Staff") hereby files its response to TEP's Motion. Staff agrees with TEP that it may be appropriate to delay TEP's final Code of Conduct filing until after the APS matter has been resolved, and therefore does not oppose the extension of

1 time requested in the Motion. However, Staff wishes to clarify by this filing that any Staff
2 recommendations on TEP's proposed final Code of Conduct will be based upon Staff's consideration
3 of TEP's filing and TEP's individual circumstances in addition to the Commission's forthcoming
4 decision in the APS Code of Conduct matter.
