LEAK DETECTION PROGRAM TARIFF

PURPOSE

The purpose of this tariff is to enable Wickenburg Ranch Water, LLC ("Company") to promote the conservation of groundwater by implementing a systematic evaluation of its water distribution system to identify and fix leaks.

LEAK DETECTION PROGRAM MEASURES

In accordance with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("ACC") Decision No. 71501, the Company is required to adopt and implement water conservation measures described in the paragraph above. In support of the Company's water conservation goals and the ACC decision, the Company will implement a systematic evaluation of its water distribution system to identify and fix leaks. The Company will reasonably identify certain portions of the water service area are likely to yield the best results for this program. The Company will train staff to inspect the system for leaks during meter reads. The Company will implement this program throughout its service area.

REQUIREMENT

The requirements of this tariff are governed by the ACC rules and the Arizona Department of Water Resources' Required Public Education Program and Best Management Practices in the Modified Non-Per Capita Conservation Program from the May 2008 Modifications to Chapter 5, Municipal Conservation Program, Third Management Plan, Appendix 5-N, Water Conservation Measures.

The Company shall provide to its customers a complete copy of this tariff. The Company will implement the measures stated above and will maintain records regarding leak identification and repair for a minimum of one year.
