

Dear Mr. Olea,

On behalf of AT&T Inc. ("AT&T"), the purpose of this report is to provide further information regarding twenty (20) AT&T employees located in Arizona that were given notice of a surplus condition. AT&T notified the Commission of this potential layoff on February 15, 2010. No facility closure was involved. This report is provided pursuant to the third ordering paragraph of Decision No. 68865.

The layoff being considered was intended to improve efficiencies and reduce business expenses. The proposed reduction involved twenty management employees in the Managed Services and Operations organization. In an effort to redeploy the employees within AT&T, the employees retained access to the internal AT&T job search system. Thirteen of the employees were able to locate another position within AT&T.
