PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 5, 2010, DSI-ITI, LLC ("DSI-ITI") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") applications for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide customer owned pay telephones in the State of Arizona, Docket No. T-20734A-10-0127; an application for approval for authorization to encumber and/or mortgage its assets, Docket No. T-20734A-10-0128; and approval of the purchase and transfer of assets of ITI Inmate Telephone, Inc. ("ITI"), Docket No. T-20734A-10-0129.

On April 23, 2010, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") filed a Motion to Consolidate ("Motion"). In its Motion, Staff stated that the issues involved in these matters are substantially related and that no parties' rights will be prejudiced by the consolidation. Staff also believes that consolidation of these matters will aid the Commission in the evaluation of all three matters.

On May 4, 2010, ITI filed with the Commission, (in Docket No. T-20734A-10-0129) a

1 request to cancel its CC&N to provide COPT services in Arizona.¹ ITI's request states that it has
2 entered into an Assets Purchase Agreement with DSI and upon the closing of the Assets Purchase
3 Agreement, ITI desires to cancel its CC&N to provide COPT services.

4 Because ITI requests to cancel its CC&N upon the closing of the Assets Purchase Agreement
5 which will transfer its assets to DSI; ITI's request to cancel its CC&N should be consolidated with
6 the above-captioned matters as the issues are substantially related. Further, no objections to Staff's
7 Motion to Consolidate have been filed. Therefore, Staff's Motion should be granted.


8 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Docket Nos. T-20734A-10-0127, T-20734A-10-0128,
9 T-20734A-10-0129, and T-20608A-10-0129 are hereby consolidated for purposes of resolving the
10 issues raised in those dockets.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all parties must comply with Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules
12 of the Arizona Supreme Court and A.R.S. § 40-243 with respect to practice of law in Arizona and
13 before the Commission and admission *pro hac vice*.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that withdrawal of representation must be made in compliance
15 with A.A.C. R14-3-104(E) and Rule 1.16 of the Rules of Professional Conduct (under Rule 42 of the
16 Rules of Arizona Supreme Court). Representation before the Commission includes appearance at all
17 hearings and procedural conferences, as well as all Open Meetings for which the matter is scheduled
18 for discussion, unless counsel has previously been granted permission to withdraw by the
19 Administrative Law Judge or the Commission.

20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
21 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


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
