



18 captioned docket and for withdrawal of attorney Kevin T. Fox from the proceeding. A.C.C. § R14-3-104.


19 On October 3, 2008, The Solar Alliance filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission
20 (Commission) an application for a declaratory order that providers of certain solar service agreements
21 would not be public service corporations pursuant to Article 15, Section 2 of the Arizona Constitution.

22 On February 20, 2009, IREC filed a Motion to Intervene requesting temporary admission *pro hac*
23 *vice* of Mr. Kevin T. Fox. On February 27, 2009, for good cause and pursuant to Arizona Supreme Court
24 Rule 38(a), the request for temporary admission was granted to Mr. Fox and IREC was granted intervener
25 status to participate in this proceeding. On March 30, 2009, pursuant to Arizona Supreme Court Rule
38(a), Mr. Timothy M. Hogan, an attorney with the Arizona Center for Law in the Public Interest, filed a
Motion and Consent of Local Counsel for *Pro Hac Vice* Admission of Kevin T. Fox. April 2, 2009,
Kevin T. Fox was granted *pro hac vice* admission.

2 There has been no activity in the docket since July 6, 2009 and it is unclear at this time whether
3 new activity will occur. As a result, IREC and Mr. Fox respectfully request withdrawal from the above
4 captioned docket.
