**RESPONDENTS REQUEST AN APPEAL TO THE OPINION AND ORDER OF DECISION NO. 71490**

**COMES NOW** the Respondents, Steve John Rogan and Carol Ann Richey, Pro Se, Pursuant to A.A.C. 41-1092.06, hereby requests an appellate hearing to the Order and Opinion to the allegations by the Arizona Corporation Commission.

1. The Statutes that were alleged to be violated are A.R.S. s44-1841, 44-1842, 44-1991.
2. There are numerous misrepresentations and misstatements of facts.
3. Respondents disagree with the allegation of offering an investment in the form of a note under A.R.S. s44-1801.
4. Respondents disagree with the allegation of offering a security without being registered as a dealer and/or salesman under A.R.S. s44-1842.


5. Respondents disagree with the allegation of committing fraud in the offer of an unregistered security, engaging in transactions, practices or a course of business which involved untrue statements and omissions of material facts under A.R.S. s44-1991.
6. Respondents have a right to request a hearing or informal settlement conference pursuant to section 41-1092.06

**A party may obtain a hearing on an appealable agency action or contested case by filing a notice of appeal or request for a hearing with the agency within thirty days after receiving the notice prescribed in subsection A of this section. The notice of appeal or request for a hearing may be filed by a party whose legal rights, duties or privileges were determined by the appealable agency action or contested case. A notice of appeal or request for a hearing also may be filed by a party who will be adversely affected by the appealable agency action or contested case and who exercised any right provided by law to comment on the action being appealed or contested, provided that the grounds for the notice of appeal or request for a hearing are limited to issues raised in that party's comments. The notice of appeal or request for a hearing shall identify the party, the party's address, the agency and the action being appealed or contested and shall contain a concise statement of the reasons for the appeal or request for a hearing. The agency shall notify the office of the appeal or request for a hearing and the office shall schedule an appeal or contested case hearing pursuant to section 41-1092.05, except as provided in section 41-1092.01, subsection F.**

7. Respondents were not granted a review of the Exceptions to the Order presented to the Commission.

THEREFORE, based on the misrepresentations and misstatements, and the failure to provide any damaged witnesses or actual sales of alleged securities, or evidence of offers of unregistered securities it is requested that the Commission grant a hearing or informal settlement conference to STEVE JOHN ROGAN, CAROL ANN RICHEY, DEM BONZ BARBECUE RESTAURANTS, L.L.C., and PIZAZZ, L.L.C.
