Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission finds, concludes, and orders that:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. In Commission Decision No. 62773 (August 2, 2000), the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") granted California Payphone Network dba Consolidated Smart Systems ("CPN") a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide customer owned pay telephone ("COPT") services within the State of Arizona.

2. On March 30, 2010, CPN filed an application with the Commission to cancel its CC&N to provide COPT services in Arizona. The application was filed by Mr. Glenn S. Corey, chief financial officer, for CPN and states that CPN is no longer providing or never provided COPT service in Arizona. In addition, the application states that CPN waives its right to a hearing in this matter.

3. On April 23, 2010, Staff filed a memorandum in response to CPN's application to cancel its CC&N. According to Staff, CPN is in compliance with the Commission; no complaints, opinions, or inquires have been filed against CPN; CPN does not have any Arizona customers;

1 cancellation of CPN's CC&N poses no risk that advances, deposits, and/or prepayments will be lost  
2 by Arizona customers; and Staff recommends approval of CPN's application to cancel its CC&N.

3 4. Staff's recommendation for approval of CPN's application for cancellation of its  
4 CC&N, is reasonable and should be adopted.

5 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

6 1. CPN is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV of the Arizona  
7 Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-281 and 40-282.

8 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over CPN and of the subject matter of the  
9 application.

10 3. The cancellation of CPN's CC&N to provide customer owned pay telephone services  
11 in Arizona is in the public interest.




