MOTION FOR CONSOLIDATION

13 Arizona Public Service Company ("APS" or "Company") hereby moves to consolidate
14 Docket No. E-01345A-10-0262, APS's 2011 Renewable Energy Standard ("RES")
15 Implementation Plan ("2011 Plan") with Docket No. E-01345A-10-0166, the Company's
16 Request for Approval of Schools and Government Renewable Energy Program ("Schools and
17 Government Program").

18 APS's 2011 Plan was filed July 1, 2010, in compliance with the RES Rules.¹ The 2011
19 Plan addresses the implementation strategy APS will employ to achieve compliance with the
20 2011 RES requirements and to meet its obligations pursuant to Decision No. 71448. The
21 Schools and Government Program was filed April 29, 2010, in compliance with Commission
22 Decision No. 71448.² With that filing, APS is seeking approval of a new program for on-site
23 renewable energy for schools and governmental institutions that will substantially reduce or
24 eliminate up-front costs for solar energy.

25 The Schools and Government Program is relevant to the 2011 Plan, and the
26 consolidation of these matters will assist the Commission in its consideration of both.



1 Therefore, to allow for a comprehensive review of all the 2011 programs proposed by the
2 Company, APS requests that the Commission consolidate the Schools and Government
3 Program with the 2011 Plan. Further, because the 2011 Plan proposes comprehensive
4 modifications to the distributed energy incentives, APS intends that incentive levels and
5 modification to program requirements set forth in the 2011 Plan will supersede those included
6 in the April 29th Schools and Government Program filing.
