INC. TO CONTINUE HEARING DATE**


On January 14, 2000, Sulphur Springs Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("SSVEC")  
transmitted to Docket Control of the Arizona Corporation Commission for filing its Motion to

1 Continue Hearing Date of February 7, 2000, set in Docket Nos. E-01575A-98-0472 and  
2 E-01575A-97-0706 pertaining to SSVEC's Stranded Costs and Unbundled Rates. TRICO  
3 ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE, INC. ("Trico") hereby joins in SSVEC's Motion for the same  
4 reasons set forth in SSVEC's Motion and Memorandum. Both distribution cooperatives are  
5 Class A Members of Arizona Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. ("AEPCO"), whose Stranded  
6 Costs hearing has been continued until February 28, 2000, approximately two weeks after the  
7 scheduled date for Trico's and SSVEC's hearing date with respect to their Stranded Costs and  
8 Unbundled Rates. The Stranded Costs Recovery Plan which Trico may submit to the  
9 Commission is dependent on the outcome of AEPCO's Stranded Costs hearing. Accordingly, a  
10 final order should be entered by the Commission with respect to AEPCO's Stranded Cost Plan  
11 before the hearing held with respect to Trico and SSVEC's Stranded Costs and Unbundled Rates.

12 WHEREFORE, Trico respectfully requests that Trico's Stranded Cost hearing and  
13 Unbundled Rates hearing presently set for February 7, 2000, be continued until after AEPCO's  
14 Stranded Costs proceeding is completed and a final order regarding AEPCO's Stranded Cost  
15 methodology is issued by the Commission.
