

IN THE INTEREST OF THE APPLICANTS OF MCC TELEPHONY OF THE WEST, LLC FOR APPROVAL OF A CERTIFICATE OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY TO PROVIDE RESOLD AND FACILITIES-BASED LONG DISTANCE AND RESOLD AND FACILITIES-BASED LOCAL EXCHANGE AND PRIVATE LINE TELECOMMUNICATION SERVICES IN ARIZONA.

(DOCKET NO. T-20718A-09-0580)

On December 24, 2009, MCC Telephony of the West, LLC ("MCC" or "Company") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") for approval of a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") to provide resold and facilities-based long distance and resold and facilities-based local exchange telecommunication services within the State of Arizona. On May 19, 2010, MCC amended its application requesting authority to provide resold and facilities-based long distance, resold and facilities-based local exchange, and private line telecommunication services in Arizona. MCC also petitioned the Commission for a determination that its proposed services are competitive within Arizona. The Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") has recommended approval of MCC's application, subject to certain conditions. The Commission is not bound by the proposals made by MCC, Staff, or any intervenors, and the Commission will issue a Decision following consideration of testimony and evidence presented at an evidentiary hearing. Copies of the application, Staff Report, and any written objections to the Staff Report filed by MCC will be available at the Law Office of Joan S. Burke, 1650 N. First Avenue, Phoenix, AZ and on the internet via the Commission website (www.azcc.gov) using the e-Docket function.

The Commission will hold a hearing on MCC's application on September 10, 2010, at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Hearing Room 1, Phoenix, Arizona. Public comments will be taken on the first day of the hearing. Written public comments may be submitted via email (visit http://www.azcc.gov/divisions/utilities/forms.asp for instructions) or by mailing a letter referencing Docket No. T-20718A-09-0580 to: Arizona Corporation Commission, Consumer Services Section, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007. If you require assistance, you may contact the Consumer Services Section at 1-800-222-7000 or 602-542-4251. The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene. Any person or entity entitled by law to intervene and having a direct and substantial interest in the matter will be permitted to intervene. If you would like to intervene, you must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission, and you must send copies of the motion to MCC or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case. Your motion to intervene must contain the following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any person upon whom service of documents is to be made if different from the intervenor;
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer of the Company, a shareholder of the Company, etc.); and
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

The granting of motions to intervene shall be governed by A.R. 16-7-101, except that a motion to intervene must be filed on or before August 6, 2010. The granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at the hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on their own behalf. If representation by counsel is required by Rules 31 and 38 of the Rules of the Arizona Supreme Court, intervention will be conditioned upon the intervenor obtaining counsel to represent the intervenor. The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission to its public meetings. 
