“120. AWC shall continue reporting the information separately for each of its Public Water Systems, as defined by ADEQ, in future Annual Reports and rate filings including, but not limited to, Water Use and Plant Description Data.”

Page 91, Line 19: INSERT new Ordering paragraphs:

“IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Arizona Water Company shall file with Docket Control, as a compliance item in this docket, copies of its Approval of Construction from ADEQ for the proposed Arsenic Treatment Plant for the Valley Vista system’s Well No. 55-212110, by no later than September 30, 2010.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Arizona Water Company shall continue reporting the information separately for each of its Public Water Systems, as defined ADEQ, in future Annual Reports and rate filings including, but not limited to, Water Use and Plant Description Data.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Arizona Water Company is authorized to implement a new ACRM for the Sedona and Superstition systems, subject to compliance with the conditions established in Decision No. 66400. The Company shall be required to file a new application for each step of the ACRM surcharge consistent with the process outlined in Decision No. 66440.”
