PROCEDURAL ORDER
(CONTINUES
PRE-HEARING CONFERENCE)

BY THE COMMISSION:

On July 9, 2010, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Temporary Order to Cease and Desist ("T.O.") and Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against LaMel G. Young, aka Mel Young, individually and doing business as Powerball Records and Entertainment and Jane Doe Young (collectively "Respondents"), in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of stock and/or investment contracts.

The Respondents were duly served with a copy of the Notice.

On July 20, 2010, a request for hearing was filed by Respondent LaMel Young.

On July 21, 2010, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled on August 12, 2010.

On August 11, 2010, the Division filed a Motion to Continue the pre-hearing conference because the attorney of record in this proceeding has to appear before the Commission in an unrelated matter at the same time. The Division's Motion includes that Respondent LaMel Young does not object to the Division's Motion.

Accordingly, the pre-hearing conference should be continued.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **pre-hearing conference** scheduled on August 12, 2010, shall be continued to **September 1, 2010, at 9:30 a.m.**, at the Commission's offices, 1200

2 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 – Unauthorized
3 Communications) applies to this proceeding as the matter is now set for public hearing.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive
5 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


